Storage Parking Lot Completed

The storage parking lot upgrade is now complete. I want to thank **Mike Mack** for heading up the remodeling project. New modest parking fees to be charged for storing utility or boat trailers over the next five years will amortize the expense.

New Gate Code - At member's request, we have changed the gate code to a new number. The old code will still work until December 31, 2011 when it will be deleted. Your "clicker" will still work without any change. If you want to know what the new code is you must call the office as it will not be published for security reasons.

Also, a 30 day code is available to give visiting guests. You can call the office to get the temporary code which changes every 30 days.

Our 2012 budget is now in draft form and it appears likely that no increase in the annual maintenance fee is needed to

achieve a balanced budget for next year. The Board will approve the new budget at the December annual meeting. I want to thank Finance Chairman **Jim Courtney** for coordinating the budget preparation.

Annual Shareholders Meeting and dinner will be held on December 10th. Please make your dinner reservations with Pat Lovelace in the office. We do not know the cost of the meal at this time. The cost will be available later.

New black table skirts you saw installed on the Board tables at the last meeting were donated by **Wayne & Gloria Shaffer**. They looked great and can be used over and over.

Annual Ballot Mailed - The 2011 annual validation period is now over. 76 shareholders successfully validated (70%). The annual ballot was mailed to these shareholders on November 9, 2011.

BOARD MEETING REPORT November 7, 2011

Four items of new business were voted on and passed at the November 7th Board of Directors Meeting:

1. To improve background data for future motions the Board agreed to require a "Project Worksheet" to be attached to any motion.
2. Funds to upgrade our office computer equipment in 2012 were approved in the amount of \$2,500.
3. Approved placing a motion on the Annual Ballot to permit expanding an existing villa onto an adjoining lot.
4. Approved change in the Rules & Regulations to remove requirement for annual Airstream Safety Inspection.

In addition, the Board accepted a request from the Ladies Club to replace the kitchen stove at an estimated cost of \$1,500 - \$3,000.
